

# MATH 3194 Written Report Guidelines

## Department of Mathematics

Each report must be typed in Latex and should be between 2-3 pages, with reasonable spacing and margins. Reports which are littered with typos, grammatical errors, Latex errors, and the like will be returned without a grade, and you will have one chance to resubmit a report which has been returned.

A report written about a talk given in Majors' Seminar should be a summary of some part of the talk, but it need not be a complete and exhaustive description of everything that the speaker said. For example, you do not need to include every proof, application, and example that the speaker gave. Rather if a speaker talked about a theorem and an interesting application, then feel free to elaborate on that one facet of the talk. The one stipulation is that your write-up must include some mathematical concepts as well as some mathematical text - sums, equal signs, etc. - because this is, after all, a class where the goal is for you to learn some basic Latex skills.
